Read Ephesians 1:15-23

- 1. How does the Spirit of wisdom give us knowledge?
- 2. What is the hope to which God had called us? (See also 1 Peter 1:13-16)
- 3. How should the knowledge of this hope help us to make wise decisions and avoid making unwise decisions?
- 4. In what sense are we God's inheritance? (Think of the illustrations Stephen used: a gemstone hunter, a grandfather with a photo of his children in his wallet.)
- 5. How should the knowledge that we are God's inheritance help us to make wise decisions and avoid making unwise decisions?
- 6. When might we feel that we don't have it within us to do the right thing?

- 7. Why is the resurrection power of Jesus a bit like going up the Westhill with a super-rocket strapped to our backs?
- 8. How does the knowledge that the resurrection power of Christ is at work in us help us to make wise decisions and avoid making unwise decisions?
- 9. Stephen said that we don't need SatNav guidance from God; we need to know Jesus better.
 - a. What did he mean by that?
 - b. What does that mean for us in practical terms?
