#### Look at verses 1 to 15

- 2) Why do the first three types of soil not produce a crop and how does Jesus explain this?
- 3) What is different about the fourth type of soil?
- 4) What kind of 'hearing' is Jesus calling for at the end of verse 8?
- 5) How do you think Jesus wants the crowd to respond when he quotes Isaiah 6:9 in verse 10?
- 6) What detail in verses 12 reveals the seriousness of failing to listen to God's word?

## Look at verses 16 to 18

- 7) Try to list some practical things you can do to help you listen carefully to God's word and the light it shines.
- 8) How should we understand the promise and warning of verse 18?

#### Look at verses 19 to 21

- 9) Why is merely hearing God's word not enough?
- 10) What will it mean for you to 'put [God's word] into practice'? Think about specific areas of your life and the situations you are in.
