Read verses 1 to 4

- Paul says that thanking God for the Thessalonians is something he 'ought' to do (as well as being something he delights to do, presumably). Why is this, do you think?
- 2. What does he thank God for?
- 3. In context, why does Paul boast about the Thessalonians' perseverance and faith, do you think?
- 4. Can you see evidence of God at work in the same ways today at Emmanuel?
- 5. How can you make thanking God for his work in our church family a regular feature of your own prayers?

Read verses 5 to 10

6. What is God accomplishing through the persecutions and trials that the Thessalonians are suffering?



- 7. How should this help us to think more positively about suffering 'persecution' as Christians in this country (whether now or in the future)?
- 8. What does Paul say will happen when Jesus returns?
- 9. How should we respond to this knowledge?

Read verses 11 to 12

- 10. What are we dependent on God to do?
- 11. Why and how should this prompt us to pray?
