 - ➡ Why is this important for how we think of Jesus in relation to other religious leaders?
 - In view of this, how should we relate to Jesus?
- 3. How does Paul underline the supremacy of Jesus in these verses?
 - ➡ How does this challenge your view of Jesus?
- 4. If all things have been created through him and for him (verse 16), then true meaning and purpose can only be found in life by knowing Jesus.



- ⇒ Do you agree? Why or why not?
- ➡ What difference should this make to the goals and aspirations you have for your life and the way in which you use your time and energy?
- 5. Verses 19 and 20 emphasise that everything we need spiritually is to be found in Jesus.
 - ➡ Why should this give us assurance as Christians?
- 6. How do you feel as a Christian having read these verses?
