 - ➡ In view of this, how should we relate to Jesus?
3. How does Paul underline the supremacy of Jesus in these verses?
 - ➡ How does this challenge your view of Jesus?
4. If all things have been created through him and for him (verse 16), then true meaning and purpose can only be found in life by knowing Jesus.

- ➡ Do you agree? Why or why not?

 - ➡ What difference should this make to the goals and aspirations you have for your life and the way in which you use your time and energy?
5. Verses 19 and 20 emphasise that everything we need spiritually is to be found in Jesus.
- ➡ Why should this give us assurance as Christians?
6. How do you feel as a Christian having read these verses?
