3. How might our ability to extend hospitality, or our need to receive hospitality, change through different seasons?

4. What will hospitality look like if it is tailored to the needs of others?
 - What different forms might hospitality take?

5. What possibilities might open up if we plan to be spontaneous?

6. How can hospitality help to deepen the family ties that exist between us?
 - What opportunities might hospitality provide to encourage each other in our shared faith?

7. How do you feel about the thought of offering hospitality having talked about it together?
